She attended recruit training in Fort Jackson, SC. After recruit training she was sent to AIT in Fort Lee, VA. Directly after that she was sent to Fort Leonard Wood, MO for PVOC training. During her time in the ANG, Midgie achieved the rank of Specialist (E-4) and earned the National Defense Service Ribbon, and the Army Service Ribbon.

One of the things Midgie enjoyed most about her time in the ANG was the comradery, and a sense of being part of something bigger than yourself. Working together to complete a mission is something she brings into everything she does. She was very disappointed that she never got a chance to deploy or to serve overseas.

Midgie shared one story about her time in the ANG . . . While her unit was deployed overseas, she remained part of the rear detachment. Her primary MOS had her working in the motor pool. The acting First Sergeant of her unit was only qualified to drive one of the vehicles in their pool. Midgie was qualified to drive anything and everything in the pool. Along with that, she was also qualified to work on everything in the pool.
