

POST 560 VETERAN OF THE MONTH!

We are introducing a new feature in our newsletter and calling it the "Veteran Of the Month".

We're happy to announce that we are starting this off by highlighting someone we all know and love as our Veteran of the Month for November 2024 . . . **Del Whittlef.**



Del has been a very active member of Kriesel-Jacobsen Post 560 in Zimmerman for the last 45 years. He is currently our Sgt-At-Arms and keeps us all in line at meetings. Del and his wife JoAnn have 4 children. JoAnn is also a member of our Auxiliary Unit 560.

Del was a member of the MN Army National Guard from November 1960 thru November 1966. He went to basic training at Fort Leonard Wood, MO. After which he attended ISRO (Intermediate Speed Radio Operator) school at Fort Dix, NJ. From there he worked as a Morse Code radio operator during his drill time at Camp Ripley. At first working with Morse Code was a tough task as he always felt like he was 5 or 6 words behind. In order to graduate they

had to send or receive 35 words per minute minimum. Del graduated with 42 words per minute.

One of the things Del enjoyed during his time in the Guard was the great bunch of guys he served with. While at basic training, he was in the fourth platoon. The furnace backed up and there was 2 inches of coal soot covering everything. The whole platoon was pulled out of training for 2 days to get it all cleaned up.

One story from his time in the Nat'l Guard was that on one day he was assigned to drive a Colonel around during a battery test. They were following 2, 8-Inch guns and they stopped about 50 yards behind the guns. Del had the jeep he was driving in park with the emergency brake set. When they fired both guns at the same time, the recoil and percussion moved the jeep back about 6 inches. He also recalled that with the radios he was using, if you held a fluorescent light bulb next to the antenna, and then keyed the microphone, the light bulb would light up. In his words, "That just shows the power those radios threw out."
